Vietnam

RCN market: The market is a bit active. Price is decreasing a bit and there were more interest or bids from buyers last week. Even now, these levels are still not at parity with prevailing kernel prices, buyers would like to cover some quantity as they are out of RCN for their processing.

Cambodia crop is yet to pick up, it is coming but in small quantities.

Vietnamese crop is still at an early stage and the price of RCN increases a bit as there is some big rain in Vietnam. Some people said their area crop is not good but in some other areas, it is still ok.

Price is offered/traded as below:

- Burkina 48/200 for Mar to Apr at 1450 USD/MT CNF HCM

- Ogbomosho (Saki) 51/180 at 1600 USD/MT CNF HCM Mar/Apr
- Kogi (Nigeria) 50/195 at 1530 USD/MT CNF HCM Mar/Apr

Kernel market: The market is still quiet and the price remains firm. Not much demand these days. It seems buyers are waiting for prices to come down more as they are not in a hurry to buy. There is some interest for nearby like W320 at 3.15 but not many offers are available, while packers are offering like 3.18-3.20 for nearby. There is still some demand for WS, but at 2.15-2.20, while medium packers are offering the same at 2.25-2.30 and top packers offer at 2.35-2.40. There are still no demands on W180, W210, and W240 yet, although the price of these grades is decreasing.

Burkina Faso

In Burkina, the cashew season launch ceremony was held on the 15th of February 15 in Banfora. The government has announced a minimum farmgate price of 385 FCFA/kg, 75

FCFA higher than the last season. Since then the prices have risen sharply. Current farmgate prices range from 500 to 700 FCFA/kg, varying by region.

During the 2024 campaign, Burkina's RCN production was reduced by over 13 per cent to 161,000 tons (against 182,000 tons produced in 2023). In 2024, only 16,000 tons of RCN processed locally.

Benin

Factories procurement operations have accelerated significantly through industry-established buying mechanisms. Although the government has implemented strict export controls, some traders continue to find ways to circumvent these restrictions, channelling raw nuts into Togo and Nigeria wherein they command higher market prices. It is important to note that Benin's prohibition on raw cashew exports remains firmly in place, while the domestically agreed-upon procurement price, established through stakeholder consensus, stands at 375 FCFA/kg.

Cote d'Ivoire

Market conditions remain stable from the previous week. Raw cashew nut supply continues to be limited, though quality remains high. Processors maintain their active presence in the market, benefiting from their government-granted exclusive buying period. Crop prospects remain good. Purchases by wholesalers remain limited due to a lack of financing as the official window for exporters is to commence only from March 18. Farm gate price varies from 425 to 475 FCFA per kg in Bouake, Boundoukou and Korhogo regions.

Ghana

Prices continue to decline, though current averages still exceed the government's set price of 15 GHS/kg. Supply remains limited (as compared to last year) due to Ivory Coast's border restrictions on raw cashew nut movement. Hence exporters chose to go to the Ivory Coast and buy RCN directly wherein the prices are lower compared to Ghana.

Nigeria

Despite two meetings between CAPPAN (Processors Association) and NCAN (National Cashew Association), no official market price has been established. Unofficial market intelligence suggests potential price decreases from next month, leading most local processors to postpone major purchases until then. Prices in major production areas are as follows:

Togo: The official launch of the cashew campaign is scheduled for Feb 28, 2025. As per the current rule, export sales will be allowed only after three weeks of the official launch.

India

In India, the new local crop of RCN ranges from INR 155 to 180 per kg for KOR of 53-54 across the major producing states (Kannur, Mangalore, Goa and Maharashtra). The volume of arrivals is still very less and it may take up to two weeks to increase. West Africa's current cashew offers for Mar/Apr shipment range from USD 1450 to 1700 per ton for KOR of 47-51. Considering good crop prospects in most places and the market participants were of the view that the prices may drop considerably by the end of March/early April (if there are no adverse weather conditions till then). Domestic kernel market price eased up a bit owing to lacklustre demand.

Other Nuts Market Commentary

India's Almond and Dry Fruits Market Update – Week Ending February 22, 2025 India's almond markets closed this week with stable to bullish sentiments. Market trends shifted following MEWA 2025 at the Jio World Convention Centre, Mumbai (February 12–14), maintaining momentum into Gulfood 2025 in Dubai.

Demand Side Overview

After ten days of bullish trends, the market stabilized. In Delhi, Non-Pareil (NP) Inshell almonds traded in the range of ₹22,000 (US\$6.43/kg) and ₹21,600 per 40 kg (US\$6.31/kg), equivalent to \$2.25–\$2.20/lb based on origin prices. The recent price surge appears to have steadied.

Non-Pareil Kernels: Traded between ₹755 and 770/kg. However, demand has been low since last Friday, potentially slowing further price increases.

Independence in shell Almonds: Increased demand due to low availability and consumer preference for cheaper alternatives during economic distress. Traded at ₹20,900–21,000 per 40 kg (\$2.12–\$2.13/lb). Prices have surged over 10 cents/lb since MEWA 2025.

FAQ Kernel Prices for Independence range between ₹730 and 745/kg. The price gap between NP and Independence almonds is narrowing due to stronger demand for Independence varieties.

Supply Side Overview

California markets also saw a slight uptick, with buyers securing shipments for March-May. **NPIS Prices:** They are offered and traded between \$2.05 and \$2.20/lb FAS for 27/30 to 20/22 sizes, with 5–7 cent discounts on Independence in-shell almonds. Most packers actively participated in the buying rally, keeping prices stable to bullish. Market activity remained high, with traders engaged on both ends.

Walnuts Market Update

A major scam in the walnut trade has caused significant market disruptions, leading to extreme panic. As a result, buyers have refrained from importing walnuts from any origin, likely causing shortages in the coming weeks.

<u>Chilean Walnuts:</u> Prices are bearish, ranging from ₹470 to 500/kg for 30/34 sizes. Chilean suppliers remained sidelined during trade shows.

<u>California Walnuts:</u> Offered and traded at ₹370–380/kg (all-inclusive) for Jumbo Large Chandlers. Traders are offloading positions to avoid potential regulatory scrutiny.


Pistachios Market Update


The pistachio market continued its bullish trend: Iranian-origin kernels were traded above ₹1,400/kg. Iranian in shell 26/28 AA has increased by another ₹25–30/kg. California-Origin Pistachios: Stable but bullish, offered at ₹880–890/kg for Extra #1 21/27.


Currency Update

The Indian Rupee (INR) has been depreciating, closing at ₹86.60 against the US dollar, with a high of ₹86.96.

The market remains dynamic, with ongoing price shifts influenced by supply constraints, economic conditions, and recent trade events. Continued monitoring is advised.







Chart: Cashew Kernel FOB price – India and Vietnam (USD PER LB)












The rupee is unlikely to depreciate much in the near term

- The Indian rupee traded between 86.99 and 86.46 and finally settled the week at 86.57 against the dollar as of Feb 21, 2024.
- As mentioned recently, the rupee has retreated from record highs, with a near-term top in place.
- The RBI is going to conduct its largest-ever 10-billion dollar/rupee buy-sell swap auction on February 28, aiming to address the persistent liquidity deficit in the banking system.
- The rupee may gain slightly as the US dollar index hit a two-month low and on fall in its treasury yields owing to concerns about the state of the economy, as the US consumer sentiment hit a 15-month low during last week.
- .Overall, the rupee may trade sideways to lower going forward in the 86.15 and 87.20/87.45 ranges, amid more volatility.

Burkina Faso: The price of cashew nuts set at 385 FCFA/kg for the 2025 campaign

Cashew, an economic lever for Burkina Faso Burkina Faso 's economy relies largely on local processing of cashew products. Thus, to ensure the success of the 2025 campaign, the country has set the price of cashew nuts at 385 FCFA/kg, a rate that could increase this year's revenue. In addition, the cashew sector represents a source of income for 243,971 households, with an average annual production of 200,000 tonnes over the last five years.
